WHAT ARE USHERS?

Ushers are people who help the church service run smoothly. They know the church building and the routine well enough to help visitors navigate and engage meaningfully with worship. They also assist everyone with finding and using church resources like restrooms, bulletins, and first aid materials.

Ushers work with a pair of church councilmen. The councilmen are responsible for most of the prep work before worship (unlocking doors, turning on lights, changing the hymn board numbers, checking communionware with altar guild, lighting candles).

Ushers greet people as they come toward the sanctuary, help them find the offering plate, and hand out bulletins and calendars. If someone comes in a little late, the ushers are there to help them find their group that may already be seated or find open seats if the church is crowded. They also direct people to restrooms and help caregivers find busy bags and spaces for their kids to move. Ushers help people go up for communion and assist in clean up after services end.
