WHAT IS LADIES AID?

Ladies Aid is a volunteer organization that supports many different aspects of ministry, largely outside of worship. It consists of women who belong to the congregation. There is no formal membership list; all women are welcome to serve.

Much of what Ladies Aid does is not visible unless you know where to look. Ladies Aid works as the main body responsible for everything that happens in the kitchen (though other groups also assist), from fellowship time on Sunday mornings to Lent and Advent Wednesday suppers. Funeral lunches are coordinated by Ladies Aid. If you received a card from church during an illness or hospital stay, chances are it was from them. They are also behind the flowers that decorate the chancel for Easter. They offer greeting cards for sale in the fellowship hall and often buy or donate cleaning supplies and tools. Vacation Bible School lunches and craft materials are often paid for by Ladies Aid. It's a great place to find a way to use the talents, treasure, and time God has given you.

Ladies Aid meets every other month, usually on the second Tuesday at 6:30 pm in the fellowship hall. Their next meeting will be November 7th and they are always excited to see new faces at meetings! Also the snacks are second-to-none.
