VOTERS' MEETING NOV. 12

Pastor's report: New member transfer approved for Carrie Erickson; Bible studies continue at church and at Red Granite Institutional; looking to restart women's Bible studies and begin a men's class.

Treasurer's report: included in Nov. 12 bulletin. Many maintenance and special expenses have been settled but this plus offerings and tuition being down has led to a \$45,000 negative balance over 2022.

Maintenance report: lights have been replaced with LEDs for ease of use and cost savings; trees have been removed; school gym has been cleaned and updated with banners; contracted with a different company for parking lot snow removal; will need more mowers around school in spring.

Board of Education report: enrollment for the year is at 36 (6 new families!): soccer and volleyball finished their seasons; basketball season is starting with two coed teams; the school handbook was updated and completed over the summer.

Financial secretary's report: 2024 offering envelopes will be ready on time

Ushering/attendance report: average worship attendance is going up steadily. July ave: 94. August: 110. September: 124.

Long Range Planning report: Plans for a garage to replace the shed next to the parsonage are on hold due to finances. The garage is intended to increase storage space.
